### **PROXY ELIGIBILITY:**

All individual members are entitled to voting privileges.

Corporate members are entitled to voting privileges through a representative designated by proxy.

Family memberships are entitled to one vote by one adult member of the family.

Associate members are NOT entitled to voting privileges.

All proxies must be members.

### **SUBMISSION OF PROXIES:**

All those who will be exercising a proxy for a member, must hand in a completed proxy form. All proxies will be cross-referenced with a membership list upon registration.

### **CONSULTATION WITH THE PERSON EXERCISING YOUR PROXY:**

All such members should inform their proxy of their preferred stand on Bylaws amendments (if applicable), and ensure their proxy presents the required documentation at the Annual General Meeting.
