

## **The Andrew Love Memorial Award to the Intervenor of the Year**

This award was set up by the family of Andrew Love. He was a determined child who courageously overcame many obstacles to become an inspiration to those who knew him. Intervention was the key that unlocked doors for Andrew.

In recognition of the contribution that Intervention made to the quality of Andrew's life, a Memorial Award was established to be presented annually to a special Intervenor who displays outstanding skills. The successful candidate will be a dedicated and compassionate individual who has devoted time and effort to enhance the quality of life of a person who is Deafblind.

A Trust Agreement was established in February of 1991 between Thomas Love and Linda Love (Settlors) and Linda Love, Linda Mamer, Christina St. Amand and Carolyn Monaco (Trustees).

According to the Trust Agreement, the Trustees shall award the Andrew Love Memorial Award in the sum of \$200 to the Intervenor who, in the opinion of the Trustees, has demonstrated consistently high standards in his/her interaction with deafblind individuals.

### **Nomination Procedure:**

Persons interested in nominating an individual to receive this award should submit:

- a) The name, address, email address and phone number of both the nominator and nominee should appear at the top of the submission.
- b) A detailed summary that outlines the nominee's ability to enhance the quality of life of a person who is Deafblind.
  - The summary should provide information that paints a picture of an Intervenor who has outstanding Intervenor skills that are exemplified through a philosophy of "doing with, not for".
  - He/she will have also heightened community awareness of the needs of individuals who are Deafblind by demonstrating a degree of professionalism that goes above and beyond their job description.
  - Examples of school, family and/or community special initiatives are welcomed.
- c) Supplemental information that may be included could include additional letters of support, pictures, and/or input from the individual with whom the Intervenor works. However, supplemental information will not bias the selection process.

The award, which was first issued in 1991 is presented by the Canadian Deafblind Association at its Annual Meeting or during a National Conference. Usually, the award includes a cheque for \$250, flowers and a plaque.

Supporting documentation for the nominee's candidacy is encouraged, including examples of school, family and community special initiatives; additional letters of support; as well as photos and input from the individual with whom the Intervenor works.
